



Call for applications for the assignment of 1 scholarship for students enrolled in the academic year 2024/25 in the third year of a Bachelor's Degree course offered by the Department of Information Engineering and Computer Science of the University of Trento

(English translation)

Art. 1 – Purpose, recipients and application submission methods

The University of Trento and the Department of Information Engineering and Computer Science (DISI) of the University of Trento announce a competition for **n. 1 (one)** scholarship for students enrolled in the academic year 2024/25 in the third year of a Bachelor's Degree course offered by the Department. The scholarship is financed by a company as specified in the descriptive sheet, reporting the presentation of the activities and any prerequisites and constraints, and published on the web page: <https://www.disi.unitn.it/career-job-center/job-opportunities-for-student/scholarships>.

Art. 2 - Application submission and deadline

Interested candidates must submit their application by **9 October 2024** at <http://www.unitn.it/apply/serve-studenti> by authenticating with their University username and password, attaching the following documents in PDF format:

- CV in European format;
- a cover letter (maximum one page).

Art. 3 - Selection Committee

The evaluation of qualifications and any interview will be carried out by a committee composed of three professors of the University of Trento appointed by Decree of the Rector. On the basis of this evaluation, the committee will compile a ranking containing the winners and the eligible candidates. The decision of the committee is final.

The committee reserves the right to call the candidates for an interview in the event of profiles with equal scores.

Art. 4 – Final Ranking

Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of a selection process carried out through the evaluation of



qualifications and possible interview, in particular:

- 60/100 for the average grade of exams taken in the first year of the course. To be admitted, candidates must have obtained, by 6 September 2024, 84 CFU relating to the activities of the first and second year;
- 20/100 for the curriculum (in particular, the degree of satisfaction of any prerequisites defined in the descriptive sheets) and the letter of motivation;
- 20/100 based on the economic condition (ISEE value).

The ranking will be published on the dedicated University portal **at the latest by the end of November 2024**.

The scholarship winners, within 10 days of the publication of the ranking, must complete the following online application "Tax deduction request for scholarships" available at the link:

In the absence of the tax deduction request, the candidate will be considered as having withdrawn and the scholarship will be assigned following the order of the ranking.

Art. 5 – Scholarship amount, award criteria and requirements

The scholarship recipient undertakes to carry out the curricular internship and the thesis at the company/institution financing the scholarship. The amount of each scholarship amounts to € 5,000.00 (five thousand/00) gross overall for the three-year cycle.

The overall amount of each scholarship will be paid in **two installments**, of which

- the first following the approval of the university tutor and the company tutor by **January 2025**;
- the second upon obtaining a degree and compliance with any constraints associated with the scholarship indicated in the descriptive sheet associated with the scholarship (e.g. exams to be included in the study plan, etc.) by the **end of December 2025**, with payment of the installment by **February 2026**.

To be eligible for the scholarship, eligible candidates must have been enrolled in the second year of one of the Bachelor's Degree courses of the Department of Information Engineering and Computer Science of the University of Trento in the academic year 2023/24.

Scholarship winners who do not meet the required prerequisites, as per the descriptive sheet of the scholarship, will not be paid the first installment of the scholarship and will lose the assignment. The eligible candidate and the one immediately following in the ranking will be admitted, provided that they meet all the required requirements.

The payment of the second installment, which will take place by **February 2026**, is subject to

verification of the following conditions:

- achievement of the bachelor's degree by the end of December 2025;
- compliance with additional requirements associated with the scholarship agreed with the academic supervisor;
- approval of the assigned academic supervisor and company tutor.

In the event of failure to fulfill one or more of the above conditions, the students who are awarded the scholarship will not receive the second installment.

Art. 6 – Information on the processing of personal data

Pursuant to art. 13 of EU Regulation 2016/679 “General Regulation on the Protection of Personal Data” (GDPR), the University of Trento will process personal data within its institutional purposes exclusively for the performance of this selection procedure (art. 6, paragraph 1, letter e), of the GDPR.

The processing of personal data will be carried out using paper and/or computerized methods exclusively by personnel authorized to process data in relation to the tasks and duties assigned and in compliance with the principles of lawfulness, correctness, transparency, adequacy, relevance and necessity.

The data collected will not be transferred to non-EU countries. The provision of personal data is essential for the performance of this procedure and failure to provide it precludes participation in the procedure itself.

The data will be retained for the period necessary to carry out the procedure and to complete all legal obligations. In any case, they will be retained for the time established by current legislation and/or by the University regulations regarding the management and conservation of documentation produced by the University in the performance of its institutional activity.

At any time, the rights referred to in articles 15 et seq. of the GDPR may be exercised against the Data Controller and, in particular, access to one's personal data, rectification, integration, cancellation, limitation and the right to object to processing. The right to lodge a complaint with the Guarantor for the protection of personal data pursuant to art. 77 of the GDPR remains intact.
